Did you know that over 1.3 million anglers enjoy recreational fishing and that it contributes nearly \$2.5 billion to the Ontario economy? The MNRF works to maintain healthy fish stocks, which are important environmental indicators. The Broad-scale monitoring program is helping the MNRF to understand stresses on fisheries and other aquatic resources. Some 700 lakes are sampled for a variety of things and some are re-sampled every 5 years.
