WHY LYME?

Lyme disease prevalence continues to spread northward into Canada, with increasing numbers of human diagnoses. This trend is expected to continue long-term, facilitated by a warming climate that will bring ticks and associated illnesses to new areas. The threat of tick bites and tick-related illnesses like Lyme disease are not contained to wild spaces in Canada; backyards, gardens, schoolyards and municipal parks are now areas where contact with ticks is a concern. Public awareness and policy discussions have increased in recent years, but in many ways, we remain unequipped to properly prevent tick bites, or diagnose and treat Canadians suffering with Lyme disease and other tick-related illnesses. A multi-stakeholder conversation on Lyme disease in 2020 is needed to look at progress to date, identify and discuss ongoing issues, apply lessons learned for emerging tick-related illnesses and send strong united messages to all levels of government that we need timely implementation of existing strategies, and investment in research to fill knowledge gaps.

WHY YOU?

Tick-borne illnesses such as Lyme disease have the potential to affect all Canadians. This conference is intended to bring together the many groups and individuals concerned about the threats of ticks, Lyme disease and other tick-related illnesses to discuss emerging science, ongoing issues and reaffirm a collective path forward. Conference delegates will have an unprecedented opportunity to learn, share their experience, network with others working to combat Lyme disease, and find a role for themselves or their organization in a multi-sector collaborative of leaders pushing for timely and effective action for better prevention, diagnosis and treatment. The conference will bring together representatives from healthcare, research, recreation, government, public health, outdoor education, pet health, and tick prevention.
