Attention OFAH Member:

On Monday, March 7, the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters (OFAH), in conjunction with the Parry Sound Anglers & Hunters, made formal presentations to Seguin Township on the topic of Sunday gun hunting.

Council voted in favour of directing Seguin Township staff to draft a resolution/bylaw in favour of approving Sunday gun hunting. This step ensured the issue would appear on an upcoming agenda to provide an opportunity for all residents of Seguin Township to voice their opinion on whether or not to approve Sunday gun hunting.

We have just received confirmation that Sunday gun hunting will be considered, discussed, and voted on during the regular meeting of council on April 4. The meeting will be held in the Township of Seguin Council Chambers, located at 5 Humphrey Drive, and will start at 4:30 p.m.

We strongly urge everyone to continue to show support for Sunday gun hunting in Seguin Township in advance of this meeting by one of the following methods (**written comments will be received by the Clerk's office until 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 23**):
