

How to print your tag(s)

Beginning August 20, 2019 until the hunting season ends, you can print your tag(s) from your online account.

Selecting the “Print Available Documents” button counts as your first time print.

Please ensure your printer is connected to your device and is fully operational with paper loaded before you print your Licence Summary and tag(s). Set your printer to print single sided only. You will only have ONE opportunity to print your tag(s) at home.

HOW TO PRINT A TAG

It is recommended that you check your printer to make sure it is fully operational and has paper loaded in it before you print your Licence Summary and/or Tag. You will only have one opportunity to print your game tag.

You may also visit a participating ServiceOntario or licence issuer to print a tag the first time. You can only select the print button at home once. If a tag fails to print, please call the Natural Resources Information and Support Centre (NRISC) at 1-800-387-7011 for assistance.

Step 1

Visit www.huntandfishontario.com and login to your online account.

If you haven't already set up your online account, please reference our [Create an Online Account](#) tip sheet.

Step 2

Select “My Active Licences” link, located at the top of the page.

The following Print indicators, found under the “Printable Tag” column include:

“Yes” indicates the tag is available for printing.

“Pending” indicates a purchased tag that is not yet available for printing.

“Printed” indicates a tag that has been printed.

Step 3

Select “Print Available Documents” button.

A current Licence Summary and tag(s) will display as a PDF and will open in a separate tab/window, select “Print” from the opened window.

It is illegal to alter, modify or copy a tag (except as required for notching the tag).
