Simcoe, ON – On Wednesday, February 26, ALUS (Alternative Land Use Services) Norfolk was presented with a donation of \$1000.00 from OFAH (Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters) Zone J. By supporting ALUS, these funders are helping to combine green-infrastructure with agriculture. ALUS Norfolk is a partnership with ALUS Canada, A Weston Family Initiative, a national program helping farmers and ranchers produce cleaner air, cleaner water, more biodiversity and other ecosystem services in their communities. There are now nearly 24,000 acres enrolled in the ALUS program, thanks to 750 participants in six provinces.
